General Description

Less common words: **2** less common words are identified (souvenirs; muscular).

Paraphrase: no paraphrase is coded.

Idiomatic expressions: no idiomatic expression is identified.

Collocations: **1** collocation is identified (quality time).

Appropriacy of the words used: **10** inappropriate uses of words are coded.

Inappropriate word choice: 2 times (study a *master*; see ... *snowing* before)

Inappropriate collocations: 1 time (*in* the COVID-19)

Inappropriate word form: 1 time (*culture* activities)

Redundant adverb: 3 times

Redundant preposition: 3 times

E: I'm going to ask you some questions about yourself. First of all, let's talk about what you do. Are you a student?
