Appropriacy of the words used

General description

Less common words: no less common word is identified.

Paraphrase: no paraphrase is coded.

Idiomatic expressions: no idiomatic expression is identified.

Collocations: no collocation is coded.

Appropriacy of the words used: 7 inappropriate uses of words are coded.

Inappropriate word choice: 5 times (formal *look*; *career* place; great *reputations* *with*; *job* place)

Inappropriate collocation: 1 time (*build ... with*)

Unclear meaning: 1 time (*get my passions*)
